we miss the opportunity. You may ask why did God put us in a world where time is such a problem, everything ages and decays all around us what is new and very up to date is discarded as obsolete almost immediately, only the things of the Spirit are eternal and last for ever.

that it's a cop out from life," but if we walk in grace we find that we are constrained by the love that provided it. Paul says in 2 Cor 5: 14 "For the love of Christ constraineth us". Grace doesn't promote sin as Paul says in Rom 6:1, "Shall we continue in sin, that grace may abound? God forbid." Instead the grace of God becomes a constant force within us to live up to the higher standard that God has entrusted us with through that grace. That grace gives us an assurance, that keeps us from guilt and condemnation that the devil throws at us when we feel we have fallen short. Rom 8:1 says, "There is therefore now no condemnation to them which are in Christ lesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. For the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus hath made me free from the law of sin and death." The law of the Spirit here is 'the grace that lesus brought in John 1:17 "grace and truth came by Jesus Christ." Not the law of Moses but, Eph 2:8 "For by grace you have been saved through faith, and that not of yourselves; it is the gift of God,".

The greatest thing this grace has done for all of us and me personally, is to make it possible to enter the Glory zone, the realm beyond the veil of our flesh where time stands still. There we are consumed by the overwhelmingly Glorious presence of God. I am a Glory man, thank God for Henri who inspired that precious vision in me; I am convinced there's nothing else which satisfies my being like being lost in the Glory of God.

I am addicted to it, the Glory I mean, I can quite understand how Enoch walked into the Glory and was swallowed up by it, as the Bible Gen 5:24 says, "Enoch walked with God and he was not". Enoch walked out of time, time ceases to function in the Glory Zone, get tuned into heaven start to worship, get swept into the Holy place before the throne, and you never know you might like Enoch get caught away.



We know there are different kinds of prayer: the prayer of faith, intercession and supplication to name but a few but we would like to share our experiences of Spiritled prayer. Prayer is an essential part of everyday life for the believer; it provides us with the opportunity to commune with God. Many of us begin our prayers by making

our requests known to God (Philippians 4:6); you could say we are praying for our will to be done! This is necessary but the benefits of Spirit-led prayer are much higher, for it allows the Spirit to reveal His will and in doing so, reveals His heart.

Over the years we have spent many hours in this kind of prayer. Often we may have a particular person or need that we bring before Him and we pray with our own understanding, then we continue to wait for the Spirit's lead to see what His will is. Only He knows and understands the heart of a man and what His innermost needs are. The Message Translation puts it like this,"The Spirit, not content to flit around on the surface, dives into the depths of God, and brings out what God planned all along. Whoever knows what you're thinking and planning accept you yourself? The same with God—except that He not only knows what He's thinking, but He lets us in on it.' (I Corinthians 2:10-11).

When we pray we are intimate with Him. His love (you could say, his desire to share Himself with us) is unfathomable but nevertheless it is His intention that our experience and revelation of His love should grow. This is clearly seen in Paul's prayer for the Ephesians, The Message Translation says, 'that Christ will live in you as you open the door and invite him in. And I ask him that with both feet planted firmly on love, you'll be able to take in with all followers of Jesus the extravagant dimensions of Christ's love. Reach out and experience the

breadth! Test its length! Plumb the depths! Rise to the heights! Live full lives, full in the fullness of God.' (Ephesians 3: 17-19).

It is a beautiful experience, especially when you are alone with Him. We have both had memorable experiences where the Spirit has led us to pray. Now we would like to share our own personal testimonies.

Annette: I have recently had two instances where the Spirit has led me to pray for two different people. I can say with certainty that it was the Spirit who initiated the first prayer for I wasn't in 'prayer mode' in fact I had been speaking on the telephone, just having a brief, ordinary conversation, but the minute I put the phone down I started to cry! The tears though were not mine! I discerned this was the heart of the Spirit and yielded myself to Him. Scripture came out of my mouth, mixed with tears. The closeness I felt with Him was tremendous! I felt His emotion and love for the person He was calling out to.

The second experience was similar, yet completely different. I had a desire to pray for one of my nearest and dearest so I began to pray in my natural mind and in tongues. Soon the Spirit honed in on one particular friend of his. This time I cried and prayed my heart out (so to speak), I felt such compassion. It was powerful; it was as though the Lord was emptying the contents of heaven for him saying 'Take it all!'. Just to add, I'm pretty sure that this friend isn't saved yet! But I know he will be!

Julie: I discovered that a lady whom I have never met, prayed for me every day for years when I was growing up. At the time I had many difficulties and I believe that her prayers saved my life on many occasions! How amazing God laid it on her heart to pray for me in that way simply because He cares so much!

Prayer is such a powerful, dynamic way of relating to God and changing people's lives. Prayer changes things! It is the primary way God's will is brought to pass. We are active participants in bringing His kingdom to pass on the earth. We need to understand that, 'we are labourers together with God.' (I Cor 3:9 KJV). Giving ourselves in prayer is so rewarding so let's all pray more!

- hallelujah!



Every time someone gets healed or touched by the Spirit of God on the street, whether that's through prayer, praise and worship, It always opens the door for the message of the Gospel to be heard. When someone has felt something real and they see it works their heart is open. People place their faith in Christ. It's quite simple really.

We have seen amazing miracules on the street, people have been healed of a wide variety of illnesses. It's such an exciting time. There's always something new that happens every time, many are saved lives are impacted. One time we laid our hands on a woman in a wheel chair, after repetitive prayer she started to move her legs. She hadn't done so for fifteen years!

Don't give up, but press on. We are getting the breakthrough because, "He that is in you is greater than he that is in the world" (I John 4;4)

SELF DISCHPLING

I don't know if any reader can identify with me and suffers from a lack of self—discipline? When life suddenly picks up pace and you struggle to keep up, I think self-discipline is more necessary than ever to live a righteous and honourable life, doing what is needed rather than wasting time on things which are unnecessary and of little consequence. I find myself flying by the seat of my pants sometimes, just about making appointments and relying far too heavily on the Lord to aid my memory and get me out of a pickle rather than being in calm control!

I was particularly frustrated with myself a few weeks ago and made a concerted effort to get up early and seek the Lord for the day ahead and various other issues. I was pouring out my heart and thoughts to the Lord when it struck me that self-discipline could otherwise be translated as 'self-control' and is a Fruit of the Spirit! This may be perfectly obvious to some but to me was a fresh revelation. How marvellous! God has thought of everything we will ever need and has made this fruit available to us.

I Cor 2:12 says "Now we have received, not the Spirit of this World, but the Spirit who is from God, that we might know the things that have been freely given to us". Verse 14 says "but the natural man does not receive the things of the Spirit of God, for they are foolishness to him, nor can he know them, because they are spiritually discerned." We have a wonderful advantage having access to these gifts.

Galations 5:22-25 says "But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, longsuffering, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control. Against such there is no law. And those who are Christ's have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit".

I like how the Message translation puts verse 24, it says "We develop a willingness to stick with things, a sense of compassion in the heart, and a conviction that holiness permeates things and people". We only need to look at the previous verses in Chapter 5 to see the ugliness of the works of the flesh. But as verse 25 says, "if we live in the Spirit let us walk in it and be fruitful".

Peter also encourages us and writes in 2 Peter 1:7 that We have some great and precious promises given to us and through them we might be partakers of (to have and to live from) the Divine Nature. He tells us "we are to have all diligence to add to our faith- virtue, and to virtue-knowledge, to knowledge -self-control, to self-control- perseverance, to perseverance godliness, and to godliness- brotherly kindness, and to brotherly kindness -love". Verse 8 says "For if these things are yours



and abound, you will be neither barren nor unfruitful in the knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ".

So when things become too much we need to check our stance, be disciplined to spend time with the Lord even when we don't think we can spare it). It will bear fruit and help us to discern what is needed from what is not. Turn the promises into prayers where we lack anything.

The knowledge talked about above, will increase our awareness of the whole truth and will of God. I believe this applies to our whole life and I need his wisdom and knowledge in my work life more than ever and I'm relying on Him for it.

In 2014, my prayer for all of us is that we might know Him more; experience more of the gifts He has already given us and to bear much fruit; Self-discipline being
